Everex XT Series Quick Setup Guide

1. Installing the Battery Pack

Insert battery in the battery compartment located on the bottom of the computer.

2. Plugging the Power Cable (Figure 1)


- 1) Plug the AC adapter connector to the DC-IN socket on the rear side of the computer.
- 2) Plug the power cable to the AC adapter.
- 3) Plug the other end of the power cable to a live wall outlet.

3. Opening the Display Panel (Figure 2)

- 1) Face the front side of the computer, position the latch to the center of the display panel.
- Slide the display latch to the right and raise the display panel.
- Adjust the display to a comfortable viewing angle.


4. Turning on the Computer


To turn on the computer, press the power button and hold down for 2 seconds. The power LED on the panel will light up to indicate that the computer is on.
